

I Can Discovery Program

New Life Christian School is the home of the I Can Discovery program run by private contractor and director Mrs. Lorraine Kemp, who has been a therapist at NLCS since 1994 serving over 80 students. She is a professionally certified and licensed member of the National Institute for Learning Development (NILD), as well as a certified dyslexia therapist through the International dyslexia Association (IDA).

NILD trains therapists to be able to meet the needs of students who struggle with learning through educational therapy. Therapists work with students who have difficulty maintaining average grades within the normal classroom setting and have a diagnosed learning disability. Responding directly to this challenge, educational therapists are licensed and professionally certified. This level of certification is expected of most NILD educational therapy programs. Therapists work towards this certification and must maintain it annually by earning CEU's pertaining to educational therapy or trends in working with students with learning needs.

Referral Program

Students who struggle with learning are usually identified by their classroom teachers or referred by their parents for further analysis through testing to find out why the student is struggling. Several steps are followed within the guidelines of the Referral Program.
